- There are eight (8) classes.
First and Second Place only. Some bikes can enter in more than one class.
- Bikes will be judged on condition of over all bike, execution of design and the originality of its style.
- Neatness of wiring fuel lines and cables are expected to be in good order and cleanly installed.
- This is a "Ride In" show. Bikes should be in running condition.
"Trailer Queens" are not eligible for First Place.

- 1. Stock** Original models - as it came from the manufacturer with less than 6 accessories- Judged on Original Details and Overall Aesthetics
 - 2. Custom** Street bikes that do not appear stock but are without radical modification to frame or drive train. Judged on Paint and Metal, Design & Modification, Originality, Ridability and Overall Aesthetics and More than 5 accessories
 - 3. Radical Custom** Extreme Custom Bikes - Fabricated or Modified outside the bounds of any production Bike. Judged on Paint & Metal, Design & Fabrication, Originality & Innovation and Extreme Aesthetics.
 - 4. Baggers/Touring** Touring bikes or Dressers, equipped with saddle bags - Judged on Paint & Metal, Styling and Overall Aesthetics.
 - 5. Sport/Competition** Drag, Sport or Racing Bikes Drag Bikes - Judged on Paint & Metal, Drive Train Components & Performance, Frame Design & Fabrication and Overall "Go Fast" Aesthetics.
 - 6. Vintage** 1980 Models or older that reflect a "Nostalgic" Styling. - Judged on Paint & Metal, Styling and Overall "Nostalgic" Aesthetics.
- Peoples Choice** Spectators Choice is based on the only relevant vote, which is from the festival crowd. This makes the People's Choice award a far more coveted trophy.
- Mayor's Choice** The Mayor's Choice Award is an initiative of The City of Middletown and the Middletown Blues and Bikes. It is unique in Butler County as the winner is determined by an individual with mental retardation and or other developmental disabilities and not by a panel of judges as their choice for excellence. Its purpose is to publicly identify the interest in the welfare and lives of people with developmental disabilities. Everyone should have opportunities to participate in community life with fellow citizens and to develop a sense of belonging to the community. This makes the Commissioner's Choice award the most coveted trophy.
